Dear PTA President,

Are you looking for a great, new fundraiser for your school? Howell Living History Farm's award-winning corn maze, now in its 15th year, can help you raise hundreds (or more) for your PTA or PTO through its MazeDays Program, offered once again this fall.

The program shares 50% of the box office with partner organizations like yours – organizations looking for fun, educational activities that bring students and their families together as they contribute to your fundraiser.

How does it work?

During the month of September, our maze staff will record each paid admission associated with your school, and at the end of the month send you a check for half the total revenue. All you have to do is encourage students and their families to attend the maze on any open weekend in September and present your school's coupon, which they can print from our website to identify themselves as members of your school. Tickets cost \$8 for ages 10 & up, \$6 for ages 5-9 (children 4 and under are free), so if 100 parents and 100 students from your school participate in the program, your PTA/PTO will receive a check for \$700.

To assist you with your promotional efforts, we will provide you with rack cards, sample gameboards and puzzle pieces and aerial photos of previous mazes. We will also give you 10 admission tickets that you can use in your school's silent auction or as doorprizes at your school's events.
